GUIDELINES FOR PREPARATION OF 'COUNTRY REPORT'

The SRD Program includes a **'Country Report Session'** will provide a forum to share information about participating countries' current status and circumstances. It aims to provide appropriate solutions and insights to the identified problems and issues of the participating countries.

The Country Report should be prepared in Power Point or MS Word format with a length not exceed twenty (20) A4-sized pages. It should be written in English and double-spaced. The participants will be required to give a 15-minute presentation on their country report individually or as a group. For more effective presentations, a projector, slide projector, overhead projector, and multimedia TV will be available (PowerPoint presentations are preferred).

TOPICS TO BE COVERED:

Based on what you have presented and learnt throughout the courses, you will be required to prepare and present an **Action Plan** on the last day of the training program. The country report should be focused on fields of capacity building for rural development, not on general information of the country. So that the country report presentation session may be continued to a discussion dealing with the present issues in the field.
