Introduction

Poverty is a significant global socio-economic issue, with around 700 million people living on less than \$2.15 per day, as reported by the World Bank. Extreme poverty is especially prevalent in Sub-Saharan Africa, conflict-affected areas, and rural regions. The pace of global poverty reduction has been compromised due to subdued economic growth and other factors and the Sustainable Development Goal of ending extreme poverty by 2030 seems unattainable. Addressing poverty requires tackling its multiple dimensions, including equitable access to health, education, basic infrastructure, and digital services to improve overall well-being. Social welfare programmes are in this context, very crucial initiatives alleviating poverty.

In Pakistan, the lower-middle-income poverty ratio was about 40% in 2023-24 and is projected to decrease to 37% in 2024-25. State-sponsored social safety nets like the Benazir Income Support Programme (BISP), Pakistan Bait-ul-Mal (PBM), and other initiatives play a crucial role in alleviating poverty. BISP, launched in 2008, is one of the largest federal unconditional cash transfer programmes in South Asia, with 9.4 million beneficiaries. Additionally, the Ehsaas Programme, launched in 2019, aims to reduce inequality and uplift marginalized areas through various initiatives, including interest-free loans and vocational training. Other programmes, such as the Pakistan Poverty Alleviation Fund (PPAF), Employees Old Age Benefit Institution (EOBI), and Akhuwat Foundation, also contribute significantly to poverty reduction by providing financial assistance, pensions, and interest-free loans to the needy.

- Must be conversant with ICT and willing to undertake online training programme.

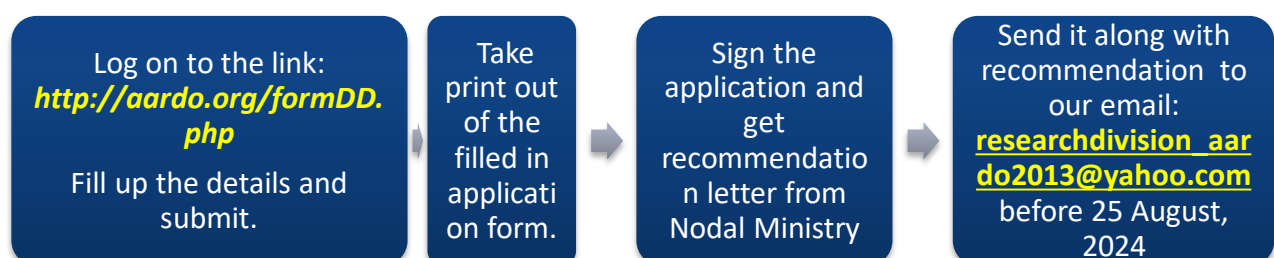
Who Can Apply
